### Council Minutes

June 6, 2019

Eldon Scott called the meeting to order at 6:30PM.

Pastor David gave the devotion regarding seeing abundance not scarcity.

Treasurer's Report: reviewed with Lori Feil. Discussion of overseas missionaries to monetarily support will continue.

Secretaries Report: Linda Thomas made motion to approve and Elaine Daniels seconded. Minutes approved as submitted.

#### **Old Business:**

Sanctuary/Parish Roof: Dave Lundy said the north side of roof will be inspected at insurance agent's request.

Youth Director Search: Elaine Daniels reported no update, may consider partnering with another youth group.

Boys Choir Visit: Stew Hall reported 10 families will house the participants. The women's guild will provide dinner for boys on Saturday and after the performance the choir and audience will be invited to ice cream and cookies. Announcement of choir performance has been mailed to area churches, newspapers contacted, and posters are available.

Showcase for memorabilia: John Stock initiated discussion of case needed, where to locate and what will be displayed. One initial quote submitted, when plans finalized, John will follow up with more quotes.

Camera/Lighting: Dave Lundy reported positive feedback from new lights. An article will appear in Echo to explain why lights are being replaced.

Castors for Chairs in classroom: easy sliders are being trialed.

**New Business:**

Parking Lot: Congregational meeting 6/16 to approve additional funds to seal/patch/paint parking lot. Discussion on budgeting funds each year to accumulate (4-5) years for parking lot maintenance.

Budget for grounds maintenance: Bruce Balsdon is considering retiring as grounds keeper. Money will need to be allotted for grounds maintenance in 2020 budget and seek bids for a new provider.

Elevator/Lift: Dave Lundy reported the elevator passed annual safety inspection. Next year's budget will need to reflect maintenance fees for elevator.

Linda Epperson encouraged council to consider a full work day with lunch provided for inside and outside of church sometime this fall.
